NARRATOR: Didn't that already happen? Like, a long time ago?



Someone from the Chorus hangs up a "No Vacancy" sign.


JOSEPH: Don't worry. I'm sure the angel will appear and tell us what to do.


SHEPHERDS: That's amazing! Where can we find him?

WISEPERSON 3: Good idea! Let's bring him gold!


WISEPERSON 1: And frankincense and myrrh!

WISEPERSON 3: What are frankincense and myrrh?


WISEPERSON 1: Things that smell really good!


