INTRODUCTION

Cradle and cross are inextricably connected on the fourth Sunday of Advent. Between a lovely tribute to the little town of Bethlehem and the blessed virgin Mary's magnificent song of praise, the letter to the Hebrews reminds us in no uncertain terms that Christ's advent is for "the offering of the body of Jesus Christ once for all." It is the kind of tension in which the church always lives as when in the holy communion—with high delight—"we proclaim the Lord's death."

Lighting of the Advent Candle

What are these candles for?

This is an Advent candle ring. It shows the circle of God's unbroken love.

There are four candles.

We shall light a new candle each Sunday from now until Christmas.

What is the point of doing this? Because the old proverb is true: "What I hear, I forget. What I see, I remember. What I do, I understand."

As we light our Advent candles, may they bring us together in the warm light of God's love.

The Gospel of Luke tells how Mary meets her cousin Elizabeth: When Elizabeth heard Mary's greeting, the child leaped in her womb. And Elizabeth was filled with the Holy Spirit and exclaimed with a loud cry, "Blessed are you among women, and blessed is the fruit of your womb." (*Luke 1:41-42*)

God speaks in many ways: through dreams, visions, new ideas, and the kicking of a child not yet born. We light our fourth candle, asking that we may hear God's call in our body, mind, and spirit.

(Light the fourth candle.)

Living Christ, give us faith to trust you, hope to follow you, and love to live for you.

We trust you, we love you, we praise you. Amen.
