

Betty A. Colby July 23, 1922 - October 27, 2021

Betty (Bliton) Halvorson Colby, age 99 died on Wednesday, October 27, 2021 at the Lake Mills Care Center in Lake Mills, Iowa.

Funeral services for Betty will be held at 11:00 AM on Monday, November 1, 2021 at Salem Lutheran Church, with Rev. Joel Guttormson officiating. Burial will be in Bristol Cemetery, rural Joice, IA Visitation will take place one hour prior to the service at the church.

Betty Ann Colby was born on July 23, 1922 in Worth County, Iowa, daughter of Newell and Anna Bliton. She was a resident in this area her entire life. After Joe's death, Betty married Royden Colby in 1994 and were married until his passing in 2006. Betty also worked 22 years in the Accounting Department at Fleetguard, now Cummins. Betty enjoyed reading and going on bus trips with her friends.


