Jerome E. Hermanson, age 86 of Lake Mills, died on Friday, September 10, 2021 at his home in Lake Mills.

Jerome Ellis Hermanson was born on July 5, 1935 near Kiester, MN to parents Emil and Ruth (Olson) Hermanson. Jerome graduated from Scarville High School in 1953. On September 22, 1956, he was united in marriage to Judith (Peterson). To this union, four children were born: Mary, Jeffrey, Lori, and Kathy. The couple started their married life living in Albert Lea, MN for about two years before moving to Lake Mills - where they have been residents ever since. While in Albert Lea, Jerome worked for a couple electric motor repair businesses before starting Hermanson Motor Service in Lake Mills in the early 80's. He continued to stay in business for over 30 years until his retirement.

Whether it was building his own car, the "Raccoon Racer," or building guitars from cigar boxes, Jerome never ran out of projects!
