

Mary E. Swenson March 08, 1923 - March 18, 2023

Mary E. Swenson, age 100, died on Saturday, March 18, 2023, at MercyOne North Iowa Hospice in Mason City, Iowa.

A funeral service will be held at 2:00 PM on Friday, March 24, 2023 at Salem Lutheran Church, 401 S. Lake St. in Lake Mills, with Pastor Joel Guttormson officiating.

Burial will be in Salem Memorial Cemetery, rural Lake Mills.

Mary attended country school and was later employed as a hired girl for local farmers, helping with cleaning, cooking and other chores on the farm. She also worked at Fleetguard for many years.

Eventually, Mary moved in with her sister, in rural Lake Mills. In May of 1940, she was married to Charles Olson in the Scarville Synod Lutheran Church parsonage, and in later years, this relationship ended in divorce.

Mary met Wallace "Wally" Swenson, and they were united in marriage in March of 1967 at West Bend, Iowa. They made their Lake Mills their home, where Mary has remained ever since.

Some of Mary's hobbies include sewing, crocheting, reading, gardening, bowling, and she loved lutefisk. Mary was active in the Lake Mills Senior Center where she was a very competitive card player and would enjoy visiting with her friends. She had been a member at Salem Lutheran Church since the 1960's where she took part in church circle, and she had been a member of the Synod Lutheran Church ladies aid.
