Growing up, Ryan was blessed with great parents and a big brother Al, and he is related to a large portion of north Iowa, through both the Fjelstad and Brekken sides. Even with all those people keeping an eye on him, he still managed to get into mischief. (This is the part where Ryan would

blame his wrong-doings on his friends, even though we all know better.) He loved to reminisce with his buddies, Jay, Dan, Justin and Josh about all the wild times they had together. And, when someone Ryan knew was in need, he would be the first person to lend a hand, give support, or even give the shirt off his back. He was a self-less man.

Later in life, Ryan was lucky enough to get Andrea Belshan, his Love of a Lifetime, to marry him. The two were wed on September 25, 2022. Between them both, they have four great kids to be proud of: Matthew, Andrew, Taylan and Olivia. Ryan and Andrea made each moment count and they brought each other joy.
